Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 1068 is the Interior Design Voluntary Registration Act.

Section 3 and 4 provide definitions and requirements to be a registered interior designer. Applications are to be submitted to the State Treasurer, along with a fee determined by the State Treasurer.

Section 9 requires the State Treasurer to operate an interior designer registry listing registered interior designers and remit fees collected under the act for credit to the State Treasurer Administrative Fund. The Secretary of State may list individuals meeting the qualifications established on the registry and update the registry as needed. In addition, the Secretary of State may adopt and promulgate rules and regulations to administer the act, and prescribe individually identifiable seals to be used by registered interior designers.

The Secretary of State estimates the need for a part-time FTE to address their required administrative duties under LB 1068 and a consultant to assist in the development of rules and regulations. Their total estimate is \$11,250 in fiscal year 2020-21 and \$9,000 beginning in fiscal year 2021-22. This estimate appears to be reasonable.

The State Treasurer is unable to estimate the number of potential registrants and, therefore, whether or not they would set a fee for applications.

<b>Explanation of Estimate:</b>						

LB1068 adopts the Interior Design Voluntary Registration Act. It is our understanding that there is a typographical error in Section 9 of LB1068 as all duties of the Act are intended to be handled by the State Treasurer, not the Secretary of State. The language as currently drafted requires the Secretary of State to update the registry for qualified individuals, adopt rules and regulations, and prescribe individually identifiable seals, while the State Treasurer handles all other aspects of the Act.

It is expected that a consultant would be needed to develop policies, regulations, and to prescribe the seal upon initial implementation of the registry. Consultant costs are estimated at \$2,500 in the first year for approximately 20 hours at \$125 per hour. It is also expected that an additional 0.25 FTE would be needed to receive and maintain the list of qualified individuals. We estimate this part-time employee to cost approximately \$8,750 for salaries in FY21 and \$9,000 in FY22. Given that the related fees would go to the State Treasurer Administrative Fund, no funding is provided to the Secretary of State for the required duties; therefore, general funds are requested as the funding source.
