LB 423 requires home inspectors to register with the Secretary of State and renew their registration each even numbered year.

Section 3 requires a registration fee in an amount not to exceed XX dollars to be paid to the Secretary of State. The fee shall be in an amount sufficient to cover the administrative costs of the program.

Section 7 provides an operative date of January 1, 2023.

The Secretary of State estimates a cost of \$30,000 in fiscal year 2023 to upgrade their licensing system to accommodate the new registrations. There is no basis to disagree with this estimate. In absence of a specified "not to exceed" dollar figure, the Secretary of State is unable to project the revenue that will be collected.

TECHNICAL NOTE: The dollar figure of "XX" in section 3 of the bill needs to be amended to reflect a dollar amount.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB423 would require the Secretary of State to create and maintain a process to register home inspectors. Based on a vendor quote, adding this registry to our existing licensing system is estimated to cost \$30,000. Other than this system development cost, we anticipate that we can handle the registrations with existing staff resources.

LB423 does not provide for the amount of the registration fee that will be received by our office for these registrations, but it does indicate that the registration fee should defray the administrative costs of registration. We estimate there would be approximately 100 registrants. To offset the upfront \$30,000 development cost, an initial \$300 registration fee would defray our initial development costs. For the even-year renewals, a \$100 renewal fee would defray our ongoing costs, such as staff time, supplies, and technology fees. As the bill does not set forth the registration fee, we have not included the revenue related to the registration fee in the chart above. In addition, the bill does not specify which fund to deposit the registration fee into. We believe the intention would be to deposit the revenues into the Secretary of State Cash Fund but would suggest an amendment be made to clarify the funding structure for this registration process.
