LB389 revises Title 92, Chapter 21 of the Nebraska Administrative Code and amends §79-813.

The State Board of Education will authorize the issuance of a certificate or permit to any applicant for such certificate or permit who:

- Is a military spouse (§38-118.01)
- Holds a valid certificate or permit currently in force in another state to teach, administer, or provide special services
- Has held such certificate or permit for at least one year
- Is in good standing in all states where a certificate or permit10to teach, administer, or provide special services is held
- · Does not have any pending investigations or complaints against any such certificate or permit
- · Meets all residency and background check requirements otherwise required for a Nebraska certificate or permit
- Pays any applicable fees

The commissioner of education will verify that the applicant for a certificate or permit meets the above requirements. The applicant will not be required to meet the human relations training requirement under §79-808 to obtain such certification or permit. Such certificate or permit will be valid for at least three years and will include the same or similar endorsements to teach in all subject areas for which the applicant had been certified to teach in other states, if a similar endorsement is offered in Nebraska.

The Fiscal Impact is minimal and can be absorbed by the agency.
