Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB78 requires the Department of Veterans Affairs (DVA) to expand the registry maintained pursuant to NRS 80-414 to include those residents who meet the requirements to be issued the following license plates by the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV): Gold Star, Prisoner-of-War, Disabled Veteran, and Purple Heart.

Additionally, the bill requires individuals who wish to be issued for the aforementioned license plates to register with the DVA. The DMV would also be required to verify the individual's eligibility for said plates by utilizing the registry discussed above.

The DMV provided a fiscal note indicating that minimal programing will be required of DMV staff and that the costs can be absorbed within their existing appropriation.

The DVA provided a fiscal note indicating an additional five (5) staff hours per week would need to be funded at a cost of \$6,070 per fiscal year using General Funds. Historical expenditures for salaries compared to the salary limit do not demonstrate a need for an increased appropriation to carry out the provisions of the bill.
