Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

This bill increases the General Fund appropriation in Program 514 in FY 2023 by \$100,000 and increases the earmark for the Perinatal Quality Improvement Collaborative from "up to \$100,000" to "up to \$200,000."

The program currently receives an allocation of \$70,000. This would increase the funding to \$130,000. It is unclear if the increase is for one time or is intended to be ongoing.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB 782 amends the mainline appropriations bill LB 380 to increase the funding available to the Nebraska Perinatal Quality Improvement Collaborative (NPQIC). LB 380 currently states that "up to" \$100,000 is available for this purpose. Previous reductions in base funding to Program 514 have resulted in \$70,000 being available for the NPQIC. LB 782 would increase the Program 514 base appropriation by \$130,000 - \$30,000 to restore previous reductions and \$100,000 to increase the funding available for the NPQIC to \$200,000 by updating the "up to" language to match this new amount.

LB 782, as drafted, would appropriate \$200,000 to the Department of Health and Human Services to be used to contract with the University of Nebraska Medical Center (UNMC) for the Nebraska Perinatal Quality Improvement Collaborative (NPQIC).

UNMC will use the \$200,000 to hire an additional staff member (an NPQIC program coordinator) and to improve the delivery of and access to evidence-based health care for Nebraska mothers and their newborns by rolling out important quality improvement projects earlier in pregnancy where there is a greater chance for long term impact.
