Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 1009 is the Domestic Abuse Death Review Act. The stated purpose of the Act is to prevent future domestic abuse deaths.

Sections 3 and 4 provide definitions for the Act.

Section 5 creates the State Domestic Abuse Death Review Team and specifies representatives to be included on the team. The Attorney General shall be responsible for the general administration of the team and shall employ or contract with a team coordinator to provide administrative support. For purposes of the Open Meetings Act, the team shall not be considered a public body. Team members shall be reimbursed for expenses as provided for in statute.

Section 6 charges the team with preventing future domestic abuse deaths by:

- Conducting investigations to understand the contributing factors in domestic abuse deaths;
- Examining the incidence, causes, and contributing factors of domestic abuse deaths; and
- Developing recommendations for changes within communities, public and private agencies, institutions, and systems, based
 on an analysis of these causes and contributing factors of domestic abuse deaths which may serve to prevent future domestic
 abuse deaths

Section 6 also specifies certain actions that the team may, or shall, take. The team may enter into consultation agreements with relevant experts and may enter into written agreements with entities to provide for the secure storage of electronic data based on information and records collected.

Section 8 requires the team to conduct domestic abuse death investigations in accordance with best practices and shall review all relevant records and information in a domestic abuse death investigation to understand the relationship between the decedent victim and the perpetrator in order to make certain determinations.

The Attorney General estimates the need for 1.0 FTE to administer the provisions of LB 1009. This is specifically provided for in the bill. There is no basis to disagree with this estimate.

It appears that the provisions of LB 1009 will require additional funding beyond the costs associated with the salary and benefits of one new FTE. Since the Attorney General shall be responsible for the general administration of the team, it is logical to assume that these costs will be borne by that office. Reimbursement costs for team members will carry a cost. That amount cannot be accurately identified at this time, due to the prospective nature of distance traveled, need for lodging, and number of meal reimbursements. Additionally, it is likely that certain activities under LB 1009 may require additional funding. Some examples include, but are not limited to:

- Conducting investigations may incur travel costs;
- Consultant fees; and
- Secure storage for electronic data

These costs are not captured by the Attorney General's submission. They are indeterminate at this time, but are a likely future cost of the Act's provisions.
