## Explanation of Estimate:

LB 766 would appropriate \$50 million to the University of Nebraska from the State of Nebraska's ARPA State and Local Recovery Fund allocation for establishment of a new data center which expands the Holland Computer Center (HCC), while also consolidating the University#s data centers at Nebraska Innovation Campus.

This critical expansion of the HCC will also build on emerging research and development partnerships that UNL has established with two different artificial intelligence institutes and offer additional opportunities to leverage current national efforts for a network of cybersecurity research and service facilities. The facility will also offer new infrastructure to support the National Center for Resilient and Regenerative Precision Agriculture, the new USDA facility planned at NIC and the National Strategic Research Institute. This will include infrastructure targeted at artificial intelligence computing and cyber security which will assist in identification and prevention of national security interests and violence towards our US food production facilities. This new capacity will provide enhanced capacity for research and development with key partners in agriculture and food industries, finance, defense, space, cyber security, and medical and life sciences.
