Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB1222 makes various changes to the Mobile Home Landlord and Tenant Act and provides for the ability of the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to issue certificates of title for, and place liens on, abandoned mobile homes.

The DMV estimates an additional 2,000 certificates of title would be issued each year with each application for title requiring investigative research prior to a title being issued. This would require 1 Administrative Technician position to handle the additional responsibilities. Further, the DMV estimates additional expenses for postage and title documents as well as office supplies. Total expenses are estimated to be \$54,400 each fiscal year (see attached fiscal note for detailed break down). Lastly, the DMV estimates the additional titles issued would increase cash fund revenue in the amount of \$20,000 each fiscal year. 60-154 directs the total fee per title is \$10, with \$6 being remitted to the Motor Carrier Division Cash Fund and the remaining \$4 going to the DMV Cash Fund. This would equate to \$12,000 additional revenue being remitted to the Motor Carrier Division Cash Fund and \$8,000 going to the DMV Cash Fund. A basis to disagree with the estimates provided by the DMV is absent.

The Supreme Court also provided a fiscal note indicating they do not expect a significant increase in judicial workload and that the impact related to judicial and court staff education is able to be absorbed within existing resources. A basis to disagree with this assessment is absent.

Explanation of Estimate:

Based on how this legislation has been introduced this will require titles to be issued by the DMV. We estimate an additional 2,000 titles per year will be issued. Each title will require investigative research prior to the title being issued. As a result, the DMV will require one additional Administrative Technician to handle all of the responsibilities as required by LB 1222. There will also be additional postage and title documents to be printed at an estimate of \$1,500 per fiscal year and additional office supplies of \$1,500 per fiscal year. Additional revenue for these 2,000 titles will result in an increase in revenue to the DMV Cash Fund of \$8,000 and the Motor Carriers Division Cash Fund of \$12,000 per year for a total of \$20,000.
