Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate. LB 970 proposes the addition of nitrogen hypoxia as a method for carrying out the death penalty, complementing lethal injection. The bill mandates the Director of Correctional Services to develop and uphold an execution protocol. This responsibility involves selecting the execution method, as well as determining the necessary equipment, substances, and team training requirements.

## Expenditures

The Nebraska Department of Correctional Services (NDCS) indicates that the fiscal impact of LB 970 is uncertain but likely manageable without extra funding. They note that while adopting nitrogen hypoxia would entail equipment costs, these would be balanced by reduced lethal injection expenses.

The Supreme Court estimates no fiscal impact.
