LB 64 changes eligibility requirements for Medicare supplement policies. The bill would require that beginning January 1, 2026, applicants shall have an annual thirty-day open enrollment period that begins on the date of the applicant's birthday. The bill further prohibits insurers from denying or conditioning the issuance or effectiveness of any policy or certificate that is available for issuance in the state or subjecting an applicant to medical underwriting or discriminating in the pricing of a Medicare supplement policy because of the applicant's health status or pre-existing health conditions.

The Nebraska Department of Insurance (NDOI) would be required to provide a form that would be utilized by the issuer during the annual open enrollment period.
