This bill expands eligibility for the Rural Health Systems and Professional Incentive Act to Dietitian Nutritionists. Newly eligible Dietitian Nutritionists can receive repayment for qualified educational debts up to \$15,000 per year per recipient. This bill would not necessarily increase the funding for the program though an accompanying appropriations bill could do so. Without additional funding, the administering agency, the Department of Health and Human Services, may decrease per capita repayments or utilize a waitlist.
