Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 584 adjusts sentencing guidelines specifically for individuals convicted of certain felonies committed when they were under the age of eighteen.

The bill proposes adjustments to the maximum and minimum sentences for felonies committed by minors, notably reducing the minimum sentences for severe felonies like Class IA felonies from 40 years to 20 years while setting a maximum of no more than 50 years' life imprisonment. This allows the courts more discretion in sentencing minors, acknowledging their potential for rehabilitation. Here are some of the new sentencing guidelines for minors:

- **Class IA felony:** Maximum 50 years' life imprisonment, minimum 20 years (reduced from 40 years).
- **Class IB felony:** Maximum 40 years, minimum 10 years.
- **Class IC felony:** Maximum 20 years, minimum 5 years.
- **Class ID felony:** Maximum 20 years, minimum 3 years.
- **Class II felony:** Maximum 20 years, minimum 1 year.
- **Class IIA felony:** Maximum 10 years, no minimum required imprisonment.

The Supreme Court has stated that LB 584 will have a minimal fiscal impact and will not require any additional resources.
