- the creation of a cybersecurity team that acts to assist schools & educational service units (ESUs) with cybersecurity needs and addresses cybersecurity issues from a statewide perspective to prevent and respond to cybersecurity threats
- a curriculum component that expands & defines digital citizenship requirements for students, parents, & teachers
- a pipeline for technology careers designed to recruit, retain, & support students from rural areas in pursuing careers in technology & encouraging the students to return & contribute to their local economies
- a funding mechanism to assist in purchasing necessary cybersecurity controls & facilitating the acquisition of cybersecurity projects

FISCAL IMPACT:

There could be an impact at the district level when they implement the State Board's adopted policy but that impact cannot be determined at this time.

The Educational Service Unit Coordinating Council (ESUCC) estimates an expense of ten million dollars to implement & meet the policy requirements of LB599.
