Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 624 provides legislative intent to appropriate \$10,000,000 of General Funds to the State Treasurer in each year beginning in fiscal year 2026. The appropriation is intended to provide state aid for education scholarships to low-income and at-risk elementary and secondary students to increase access to educational choice and opportunities at private, denominational, or parochial schools.

The State Treasurer estimates the cost to contract with a third party to receive and process applications and disburse scholarship funds to be \$350,000 per year. This estimate appears to be reasonable.

LB 624's intent specifies the entirety of the \$10,000,000 is to be distributed as state aid. Under this circumstance, the Treasurer's estimate of \$350,000 per year would need to be in addition to the amount earmarked for aid.
