This bill changes the licensing of barbers, barber shops and barber schools from an annual license to a biennial license. It also creates a new category of permit for booth rental.

The change in the licensing process will increase revenue in FY 11 by \$251,460 and decrease revenue by the same amount in FY 12, the first year the biennial license is in effect. Saving in printing and postage is estimated to be \$1,688 in FY 12. The booth permit is anticipated to bring in a nominal amount of revenue.
