LB1082 in §86-103 defines the North American Numbering Plan as referring to the Code of Federal Regulations 47 CFR § 52.5 as it existed on January 1, 2026. This bill adds a new duty of protection under the Nebraska Telecommunications Regulations Act which would require telecommunications companies to protect their subscribers and customers from receiving unwanted calls or text messages from users of unauthenticated North American Numbering Plan numbers. Additionally, this bill would direct the telecommunications companies to prevent deceptive and misleading caller identification information.

This bill would become effective three calendar months after the adjournment of the Legislature.

The Nebraska Public Service Commission has indicated no fiscal impact to their agency. There is no basis to disagree with the PSC's estimation.
