LB 580 would amend the Tax Equalization and Review Commission Act to change a standard of review by the Commission.

The Tax Equalization and Review Commission indicates this could result in an increase in the number of appeals and the length of appeal hearings because it eases the standard of proof for appellants, but can not quantify any increase.

An increase in the number of appeals would result in an increase in the Commission's revenue, because there is a \$25 filing fee for each appeal, but since the number of new appeals that might be generated is indeterminate, the fiscal impact is also indeterminate.
