The bill creates the Umbilical Cord Blood Information Act. It requires the Department of Health and Human Services to provide an on-line printable publication on umbilical cord blood banking for health care practitioners. The practitioners would provide this information to pregnant women before their third trimester.

The department indicated that consultation with an expert in this field would be required. The fee is anticipated to be \$500 an hour. A minimum of 10 hours will likely be needed.
