This bill establishes a process where a person who has received notice of being place on the child abuse and neglect central registry may request a hearing. If requested, the director of Health and Human Services will appoint a hearing officer to conduct the hearing. The subject of the report may also appeal the decision of the hearing officer in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act.

Currently a person may request the department to amend, expunge or remove the record of a report of child abuse and neglect. The agency conducted 1,200 such reviews and conducted 69 hearings. Under this bill, the subject of a report could request a hearing at the beginning of the process. The department estimates a range costs between \$224,702 (\$187,252 GF and \$37,450FF) to \$889,906 (\$741,588 GF and \$148,318 FF) in FY 11 and \$193,468 (\$161,223 GF and \$32,245 FF) to \$803,285 (\$669,404 GF and \$133,881 FF) in FY 12 for additional attorneys, programs specialists and support staff to conduct hearings. The assumptions on the additional number of hearings that could result from the requirements in the bill range from 600 to 2,400.
