LR 165, by Senator Wesely. The purpose of the resolution is to study the feasibility of reorganizing state regulatory activities relating to the building industry. LR 166, by Senator Beutler. The purpose is to consider the funding of Legal Aid Societies in Nebraska and the coordination of effort between the Attorney General's office, the Court Administrator's office and other related offices. LR 167, by Senators Beutler, Labedz and Fowler, the purpose being to consider consolidation of Separate Juvenile Probation Offices with the Nebraska State Probation System. SENATOR CLARK: The next bill is 11A.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Maresh has an amendment to LB 11A.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Maresh, you have an amendment to 11A?

SENATOR MARESH: Yes, Mr. Chairman. This is just a clarification amendment. It is to allow the Department of Agriculture to use a computer. So I move that this amendment be adopted.

SENATOR CLARK: The question before the House is the amendment by Senator Maresh. Is there any discussion? If not, all those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote nay. An amendment by Senator Maresh on LB 11A. Have you all voted? Senator Maresh, I can't make them vote.

SENATOR MARESH: I hope we don't have to have a Call of the House.

SENATOR CLARK: I hope we don't either.

CLERK: Senator Clark voting aye.

SENATOR CLARK: Record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of the Maresh amendment.

SENATOR CLARK: The amendment is adopted. Do you have anything further on the bill?

CLERK: Nothing further, Mr. President.

SENATOR CLARK: Senator Kilgarin, do you want to move 11A as amended.

SENATOR KILGARIN: I move we advance LB 11A to E & R for
